### **New Association for Local Government Superannuation Funds**

Melbourne, Wednesday 6 August: Today sees the launch of the Australian Local Government Superannuation Funds Association (ALGSA), established to promote co-operation between Local Government Superannuation Funds across Australia.

The new Association will cover x funds, with a combined membership of x,000 and a total of \$x billion in funds under management.

Making the announcement at this year's Fund Executives Association Limited national conference, [name and title of spokesperson] said "This is a great opportunity to promote co-operation between Local Government Superannuation Funds across Australia and to improve the effectiveness and efficiency of these funds to the benefit of members. With more than \$x billion of investments under management, the ALGSA's members manage some of Australia's largest industry funds.

"By working together we will be able to share resources and ideas to achieve better outcomes for members. We will be committed to maximising returns for the funds our members manage and looking at additional ways in which we can add value."

Membership to the Association will consist of 'Ordinary' and 'Subscriber' Members. Ordinary Members will comprise Local Government Superannuation Funds from within Australia whilst companies, business and community groups and national organisations with links to Local Government Superannuation Funds will represent Subscriber Members.

The initial Ordinary Members of the Association are: Local Government Superannuation Scheme (NSW), Local Authorities Superannuation Fund (Victoria), City Super Fund (Brisbane), Local Super SA – NT (South Australia), W.A. Local Government Superannuation Plan (Western Australia) and Quadrant Superannuation Scheme (Tasmania).

A new website has been created to highlight the work of the ALGSA [www.algsa.org.au](http://www.algsa.org.au). The site will detail new initiatives being undertaken by the Association and provide links to its members.
